Candidates should (a) possess a Bachelor's degree or above in Social Work, Counselling, or a related discipline, and with at least two years of teaching experience; (b) be a Registered Social Worker in Hong Kong, a Counsellor, or hold an equivalent professional qualification; (c) demonstrate a good command of both Chinese and English, and be proficiency in MS office applications; and (d) exhibit strong organizational, communication, and problem-solving skills.
