

Subject Title	Rehabilitation Care Practice
Area of Studies	Applied Science
Course Cluster	Medical Science and Health Care
Programme Introduction	This course aims to equip students with the basic knowledge and skills of rehabilitation care, preparing them for further study and career development in the rehabilitation care profession. The content includes human anatomy and pathophysiology, as well as principles and practice of rehabilitation, physiotherapy, occupational therapy and speech therapy.

Learning Activities	Case study, simulations and role plays, visit to organizations of rehabilitation services and simulation ward training, projects and presentations, etc.
